 Works submitted to the competition must be original. The owner of the artwork will hold any legal liability arising from the plagiarized and/or copied submissions.

 Participants can not submit entries which previously received a prize, honorable mention, special award or displays in any national or international competitions. If such is identified, their prize will be revoked even after being presented.

 Contestants must fill out the entry form completely and submit their work, along with the completed entry form, via mail or personal delivery, by the deadline for entries.

 Our institution will not be responsible for any damage to the artwork during the process of being mailed.

• The artwork which bear signatures, names and signs and which do not comply with the conditions of the contest will be excluded from the evaluation.

The artwork which are in the violation of the Law for National Education, which serve the
political purposes, contain objectionable and derogatory expressions, and do not comply with
the general moral and ethical rules, where any corporation name is used regardless of the
purpose, will be excluded from the competition.

• The competitor acknowledges that the rights of the awarded work are granted to Tarsus SEV Elementary School.
